Many funders are updating their existing funds to focus on the COVID-19 crisis so it is worth getting in touch with organisations that you have previously received grants from as some are offering grants to current and past grantees.

Also don't forget the free online funding database, [Buckinghamshire Funding Search](#), which you can search for funds specific to your organisation as well as register for updates directly into your inbox.

Highlighted below is a selection of new funds:

- Grants of up to £10,000 are available from the Antonio Carluccio Foundation for organisations which support the Foundation's objectives of **working to feed those in need**, promoting better understanding of food origins and nutrition, or providing hospitality related training. For further information, go to [Antonio Carluccio Foundation](#).
- While not a specific COVID-19 fund, the Youth Futures Foundation is funding programmes which tackle **youth unemployment**. Grants are on a full cost recovery basis, with a funded period built in for planning and development of the programme. Delivery of the face-to-face programme is not currently expected before January 2021. Further details can be found on [Youth Future Foundation](#).
- If you run a local organisation **helping the community cope with the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic**, apply for a grant of up to £2,000 from the [Yorkshire Building Society Charitable Coronavirus Response Fund](#).
- Alpkit Foundation is offering grants of up to £500 to **projects that are helping those affected by the COVID-19 crisis**. To apply, go to [Alpkit Foundation](#).
