- [Barrow Cadbury Trust](#): COVID-19 Support Fund reopens for grants up to £50,000 or three months' expenditure, whichever is the smaller, to charities or CICs between £10,000 and £3 million that provide services and support targeted at refugees and migrants.
- [Phoenix Fund](#): Aims to put racial justice at the heart of the COVID-19 pandemic response. The initiative will support a network of Black, Asian, and Minority Ethnic charities and groups in England that are working in the heart of their communities, providing essential and emergency services, support, and education tailored to the BAME community.
Round 01 deadline is 21st August 2020
Round 02 deadline is 2nd September 2020
Round 03 deadline is 16th September 2020
Round 04 deadline is 30th September 2020
- [Volant Trust COVID-19 Response Fund](#): Registered charities, community interest companies, community organisations and social enterprises may apply. They must demonstrate how they are directly involved with the alleviation of social deprivation and how they will support vulnerable groups affected by the coronavirus pandemic.
- [Social Enterprise Support Fund](#): Opens for Round 02 applications TOMORROW at 1pm, for one week. The fund provides grants of £10,000 to £300,000 grants between £10,000 and £300,000 for incorporated organisations mainly reliant on trading income supporting people at high health risk from COVID-19, or people facing increased social and economic challenges because of COVID-19.
