EASY READ HEALTH INFORMATION

Oxford Health, together with several other organisations, has produced a useful [repository of accessible and easy read information about COVID-19](#). The resources also include easy read materials on going to the GP and hospital, accessing dental services and screening.

INQUIRY ON IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON EDUCATION AND CHILDREN'S SERVICES

Parliament has opened an inquiry to look at how the COVID-19 pandemic has affected the education sector and children's social care system. It will examine both short term impacts, such as the effects of school closures, as well as longer-term implications particularly for the most vulnerable children.
