

ROLE DESCRIPTION

VOLUNTEER PUB LUNCH COORDINATORS

We are looking for three volunteers to work with our county coordinator to support Pub Lunch Clubs in their communities. If you have two hours a month, like meeting people and want to make a difference in your local community then this is role for you!

Aim of volunteer role	To act as a local coordinator for a monthly lunch club.
Reporting to	County Coordinator provides back-up support though this is effectively an independent role.
Start date	January 2022
Assignment length	Ideally long term, but there is no limit.
Location	Weston Turnville We are interested to hear from people across Bucks who might be interested in the role as we are continually expanding the areas we cover.
Main tasks	Maintain a record of the names and contact details of attendees at the monthly lunches. Act as a host / organiser at the lunches. Collecting payment for the meals and passing on to the pub. Take bookings for the following month's lunch. Occasional telephone calls to members during the month. Advising the pub of the number booked for each lunch. This is usually done three or four days prior to the lunch date. All aspects of the role take about 2 hours per month including having lunch!
Skills/Experience	An outgoing personality. Good organiser / communicator. Telephone essential. Basic IT skills helpful (email) but not essential.
What we can offer you	This is a volunteer role so no payment. However, there is pleasure to be derived from being involved in a community activity and helping others to enjoy the same. Make new friends and acquaintances within your own community.
Additional information	The role does not require DBS check or any specific qualifications.
