# WHAT ARE THE MOST NOTICEABLE DIFFERENCES FOR YOU BETWEEN UK AND UKRAINE?

Ukraine has a lot of sweets! I like sweets from Ukraine very much. My favourite sweet is Mont Blanc, like a chocolate mountain. UK cooking is good, but Ukrainian food is better than all other countries! My Grandma, Mum, and I once cooked varenyky (the Ukrainian national dish) and a soup called borscht.
