Volunteering in Buckinghamshire

Through our Volunteer Matching Service, we boosted volunteering in Buckinghamshire >

283 volunteers placed with nearly 90 organisations – providing 8070+ volunteer hours (worth £85,000)

Registered **513 new volunteers** - a **47% increase** on the previous year

Co-developed a **student volunteer skills record** with BHSCA, preparing over **100 students to volunteer**

Supporting Buckinghamshire communities

Delivering essential services where there is an unmet need. We helped 1,800+ people stay connected and live independently >

Alternative transport options to 220 calls via the Community Transport Hub – 77% required transport to health appointments **4600 home maintenance** and **gardening tasks** carried out – supporting **600+ at risk local residents** in their homes

Regular **'Check, Chat, and Connect'** phone calls to **40 clients** – helping them to **live independently** for longer 5,330 lunches to 430+ residents through Lunch Clubs – providing regular social contact and tackling social isolation
